We are committed to an employee safety program that will eliminate employee injuries, property damage, and work interruptions resulting from unsafe conditions and work habits. In order to realize these objectives, we encourage all employees to promote safety and accident prevention and to make safety one of the District's primary concerns.

We recognize that the responsibilities for safety in our schools are shared.

1. Employees are responsible for genuine concern and cooperation with regard to a safe work place, including compliance with all rules and regulations, and for continuously practicing safety while performing their duties.
2. The District is responsible for leadership in the development of a safety program, for its effectiveness and improvement.
3. All staff and students are responsible for promoting the proper attitudes toward safety, health, and wellness. Everyone should set good examples and ensure that all operations are performed with the utmost regard for the safety and health of all, including themselves.

Safety involves personal attitude. We ask for the continual support of all our employees and students to insure the well-being of themselves and visitors of our schools.
