It is with great excitement that I announce to you all the Pojoaque Before and After (B&A) Program has found a stable home! We want you to know that we have heard the need for a place for older students and are listening. We believe that with this move we will be able to do just that.

As of Monday, October 16, 2017, the B&A Program will be available for students from Kindergarten through 8th grade! Registration forms may be found on the school website, or in your school office.

Our new home, starting Monday, October 16, 2017, is located at the Pojoaque Valley Middle School Campus. We will be using the building that once held the woodworking class. In this building we have two large classrooms that will allow us to separate age groups. The location also gives us access to basketball courts, playground and turf, and a large play area to the east of the building. The second classroom will function as a spot for our older students. This room has stoves for cooking class and plenty of room to set up homework stations and make it feel more comfortable and quieter for students in higher grade levels.

We are working very closely with the transportation team to ensure that we have busses designated for the B&A program. In the morning parents will drop students off using the same route the middle school and SGA students use. There will be a separate parking area for B&A drop off and pick up. A bus will transport the students to PRES and PVIS on time for class. In the afternoon all PRES and PVIS B&A students will ride the same bus down to the B&A building where we will have staff ready to receive them for afternoon programming. This is a direct route bus. Parents will then be able to pick up students in the afternoon.

This is an exciting season of growth for our wonderful program. The new location is packed with potential for amazing programming and afterschool fun for all students enrolled. We believe that this move is crucial for the success of the B&A program and we hope that you will be patient with us as we make this transition.
