All posters must be submitted to the LANL Community Partnerships Office by **COB March 26, 2018** for judging. They will be displayed at various Lab sites through April 30, 2018. First, second, and third place as well as honorable mention entries will be selected and posted on LANL's external website. All participants will receive a certificate for participating. Winners will have their names and entries posted on LANL's external website.

- Create a colorful poster on 8.5 by 11 inch paper illustrating your small acts to protect the Earth.
