

Participation in interscholastic extracurricular activities is a privilege and contingent upon an acceptable level of academic achievement and compliance with District policies. All class work counted for eligibility determination must be acceptable as graduation credit.

Academic eligibility for participation is established by the following standards:

1. The student must have passed all classes during the immediately previous grading period and shall be currently passing all classes.
2. The student must have a grade point average of 2.0 or better for the immediately previous grading period or cumulatively beginning with and including the second semester of grade eight (8) or during the current semester.

In addition, the student must be able to comply with the State laws and regulations, New Mexico Activities Association laws and regulations, Board policies, and any other applicable District rules and regulations.
