

No student shall be released into the custody of any organization, institution, individual, or other, without prior consent from or communication with the parents or legal guardians. Any person removing a child from the school, including the parent, shall present a picture identification (ID).

This includes law enforcement officers who, in performing their assigned duties, request permission to remove a student from the campus. In any case where officials investigating suspected child abuse come to school to place a child or children in protective custody, the documentation procedures outlined in policy 363 must be followed, with the exception of notice to parents or guardians if they are suspected of committing or aiding in the abuse.
