

The continuous learning plan for PVHS will look a little different than our other school. This is to ensure that we meet the needs of all our students in all their classes. Teachers will provide 2 ½ hours of consistent office hours. We encourage students to reach out to each of their teachers to get specifics on how the continuous learning will be done in each class. All office hours and email addresses are posted on the Pojoaque Valley School District website.

The basic concept of the continuous learning plan at PVHS is outlined below. Please keep in mind that this may be a little different for each teacher, that is why it is so important for your student to communicate with their teachers as regularly as possible.

The first 30 minutes of a teacher's office hours, the teacher will work with groups of students to deliver continuous learning by checking in and talking with students, providing expectations, guidance, and feedback. Teachers will answer questions and provide some structure and motivation to students. This may be done in a variety of ways depending on each teacher, google classroom, remind, google hangouts, Zoom, sending out links and resources and many other platforms.

The next 2 hours of teachers' office hours will be designated for 1 on 1 help to students, answering parent emails and phone calls, and preparing for upcoming continuous learning. Teachers can answer individual questions students may have, call students and check in on how they are doing or contact parents that may have questions or concerns.
